TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read carefully the terms and conditions to which you are agreeing. Changes and cancellations to bookings cannot be accepted over the phone and must be made in writing via email, letter or fax.

The booking forms a binding agreement between Bell Shakespeare and the school, and the school is liable to make payment by the due dates. Bell Shakespeare will endeavour to accommodate any subsequent request for changes but reserves the right to retain the original arrangements and charge the full fee.

It is the booking teacher's responsibility to ensure information is accurate, payment is organised and the school is notified of the booked activities. If a booking teacher leaves the school, it is their responsibility to pass all information of the booking to a new contact teacher before they depart and to inform Bell Shakespeare of the change of contact teacher.

THE LIVE STREAM PERFORMANCE

1. Class sizes are limited to a maximum of 40 students to ensure quality of viewing experience. If a school has more than 40 students, additional bookings must be made. The class fee is a flat fee.
2. PAYMENT: Payment is due within 14 days of the booking being processed. A booking is processed once Bell Shakespeare sends a deposit invoice of 25% of the total amount to the booking teacher.
3. Full payment must be received by Bell Shakespeare no later than 48 hours prior to the live-streamed performance on Wednesday 15 August 2018. Please allow 2-3 business days for direct deposits and cheques to be received. Bell Shakespeare is able to accept credit card payments via telephone.
4. SUBSIDY: Schools with an ICSEA ranking of 1000 or less can access a class price of \$150. Class price for all other schools is \$200.
5. ELIGIBILITY: Schools are eligible to view the live stream if they are located in QLD, SA, WA, NT, TAS or ACT, or are located in regional VIC or NSW and are 200km or further from Arts Centre Melbourne or Sydney Opera House.
6. EXISTING BOOKINGS: Schools with existing bookings to the *Romeo and Juliet* In Theatre performance will be held to the terms and conditions of the original booking. In Theatre bookings cannot be cancelled or exchanged for live stream bookings.
7. CANCELLATIONS: No refunds will be given for cancellations made within 14 days of the live-streamed performance.
8. BROADCAST: Schools are not permitted to record, distribute or make any copy of the live streamed broadcast.
